What is the Research Directory?

- A listing of the research projects conducted in the Catskill Region.



- The purpose of which is to promote scientific networking and collaboration among scientists working in the Catskill Region.

- The Research Directory is populated with the responses participants enter into the Project Entry Form.
 - What is the Project Entry Form?
- The Project Entry Form is a simple Google Form that takes participant responses and automatically generates a “results or project spreadsheet”.
- Acknowledging that most of our work is multidisciplinary in nature the questions are designed to be broad enough to capture all of the possible activities yet specific enough to allow the project spreadsheet to be easily searched and sorted.
- In order to encourage participation the entry form is quick and easy to fill out.

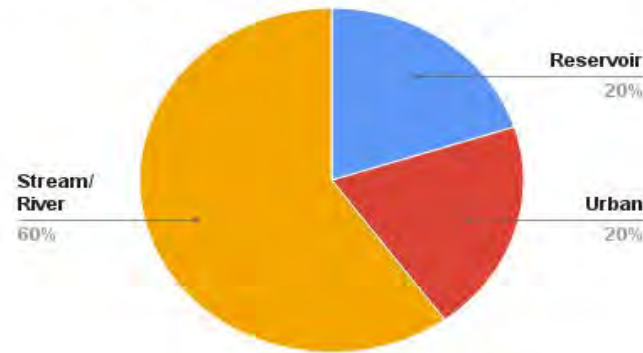

The Entry Form questions are organized like a scientific triage which will facilitate sorting and searching of projects.

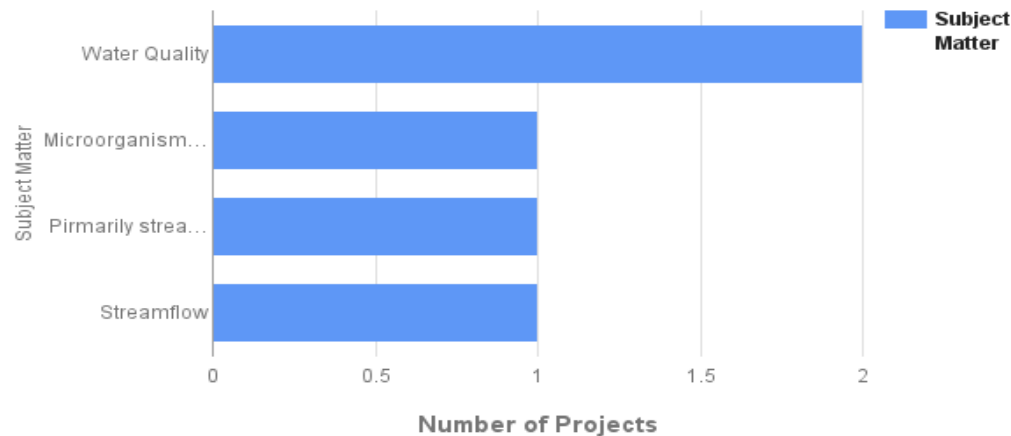
- Watershed (Ashokan, Cannonsville etc.)
