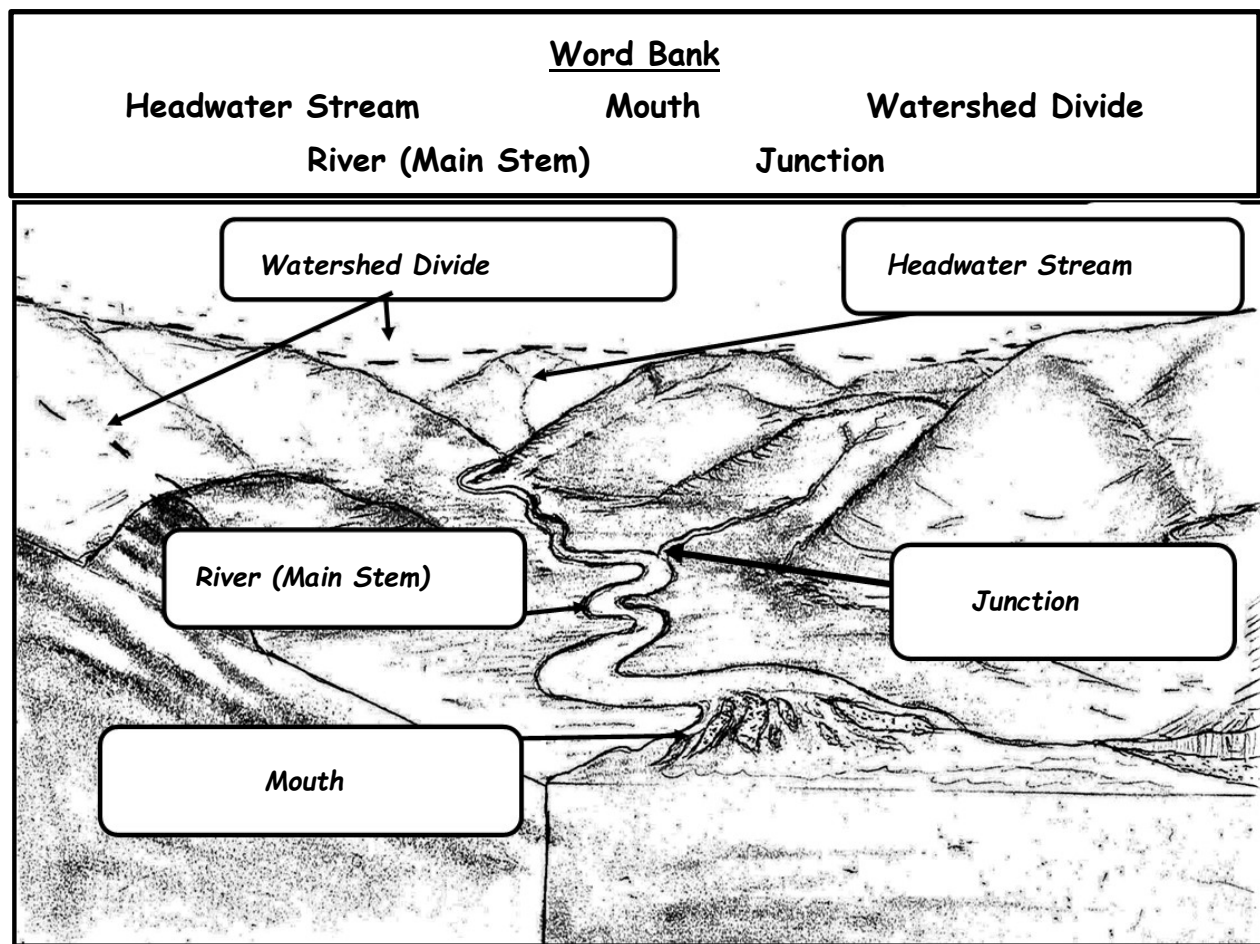

You can think of a watershed as a large cereal bowl. Any liquid that falls inside the bowl feeds the puddle at the bottom of the bowl. In a real watershed, the edge of the "bowl" is known as the watershed divide.

The whole world can be broken up into different watersheds!

The place where two streams meet is called the junction. This is also known as the confluence.

The place where the river empties into the larger body of water is called the mouth of the river.
